- Demonstrated understanding and support of the Long Term Athlete Development Model (LTAD)

Cross Country Yukon will cover transportation and accommodation costs for these events. When an interim head coach is needed on a trip, an honorarium will be provided by CCY.

Consideration

Consideration for assignment will be given to candidates who are coaching actively with youths in the Yukon and coaches who are working to improve their coaching certification. On some of the trips, gender may take precedence over other qualification to satisfy special requirement (ex. AWG).
